ADOPT-A-WALL

The Adopt-A-Wall program seeks concerned City of Rosemead residents to volunteer to assist with the abatement of unsightly graffiti. This program is a partnership between the resident and the city to eradicate graffiti. The swift removal of graffiti has shown to greatly reduce the re-occurrence of the crime. The Adopt-A-Wall program is one part of a comprehensive program to greatly reduce the cost and negative impact graffiti vandalism has on the neighborhoods and community. Program instructions:

The City will:

- 1. Personally meet with the resident to discuss the problem area and concerns of the children.**
- 2. Provide basic instructions and expectations of participation.**
- 3. Supply the correct paint and equipment necessary for the job.**
- 4. Re-supply and communicate with the resident as necessary to eradicate graffiti.**

The Resident will:

- 1. Utilize the paint and equipment to immediately paint out graffiti from the designated location.**
- 2. Complete a graffiti vandalism report form and provide it to the Public Safety Department.**
- 3. Communicate with the city as necessary to eradicate graffiti.**
- 4. NEVER attempt to detain or stop a vandal but only call Temple Sheriff's Station @ (626) 285-7171.**
- 5. Never attempt to paint curbs, poles, sidewalk to eradicate graffiti.**
