Pool Rules**

The following rules have been established to ensure the safety of our patrons and to provide an enjoyable experience for all. Patrons are expected to cooperate in observing these rules and obey the instruction of the aquatic staff.

General Rules and Admissions

- 1. All patrons must pay admission fees to enter the facility**
- 2. All patrons must wear appropriate swim attire (swim suits, trunks, rash guards etc.)**
- 3. The following items are prohibited in the pool- safety mask, snorkels, fins, cut-offs, or undergarments**
- 4. Any child under 7 must be accompanied by an adult over the age of 18 and must be with in arms reach at all times**
- 5. Lifejackets must be US Coast Guard approved**
- 6. Showers must be taken before entering the pool**
- 7. Smoking is not permitted in this facility**
- 8. The use of profanity is not permitted**
- 9. No spitting**
- 10. No loose articles allowed on the deck or in the pool (i.e. shoes, towels, goggles, sun glasses, back packs, etc.)**
- 11. No unauthorized food or ice chests**
- 12. No refunds**
- 13. All spectators must remain behind the barrier around the pool**

Facility

- 1. No running on deck**
- 2. No flips off the side of the pool**
- 3. No horseplay or sitting on some ones shoulders or back**
- 4. No diving**
- 5. Rocks, balls, or unauthorized floatation devices are not allowed in the pool**
- 6. No swinging on the ladders or hanging out under lifeguard towers**
- 7. No touching lifeguard equipment or distracting the lifeguards**
- 8. No hanging on the rope/lane lines**
- 9. Keep out of all staff areas, storage rooms, and red areas**

Slide Rules

- Must be 40 inches tall**
- Maximum operational load one person up to 300 pounds**
- Single riders only**
- Slides must be ridden feet first with the rider laying on their back and arms crossed**
- No swim attire with exposed belts, buckles, or exposed metals on slide.**
- Exit immediately**
- Goggles and glasses are not permitted on slide**
