

# City of Rosemead Fall 2023 Adult Basketball League FAQ's Sheet



## 1. Philosophy of the Adult Sports Leagues:

- Although this is a competitive program, the focus within the program is geared towards recreation. Our programs are designed to further develop more experience participants while enhancing skills such as shooting, dribbling, passing, and most importantly <u>SPORTSMANSHIP</u>.
- **CODE OF CONDUCT** Everyone must abide by the Code of Conduct or any serious violations of rules and guidelines may result in the removal, suspension or termination as a participant or spectator.
- Team managers are responsible for your players and spectators.
- Any player, coach, spectator or manager ejected from a game for any reason must leave the gym site and surrounding area including the parking lot within five (5) minutes. If an ejected player does not leave within five (5) minutes, his/her team will be imposed a forfeit. (Forfeit fees will be assessed)
- Any one player receiving two technical fouls in one game will be ejected from that game and will receive a minimum one game suspension for the next game. Any ejected player must leave the gym before play can resume. Two ejections of the same player in a season (including playoffs) will result in dismissal from the league for the remainder of the season. That person will also be banned from the athletic facility during league play hours for the remainder of the season.

## 2. League Fees

- \$375 League fees must be paid upfront.
- \$70 Cash forfeit fee must be paid before the start of the first game.
- \$35 Cash to be paid to the officials before start of each game.

# 3. League format

- Games will begin on September 24, 2023 and all games are held on Sundays, between 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
- All Games played at Garvey Park Gym (7954 Dorothy St.)
- 8 Regular Season Games two 20 min. halves
- League Standings, stats and game schedules will be posted weekly inside the gym.
- ONLY Top 4 teams will be eligible for Playoffs.
  - Tie Breaking Procedure:
    - Head-to-Head season record among tied teams.
    - Point differential in Head-to-Head games.
    - Point differential in ALL games played.

## 4. FAQ/Rules:

# • Game Time is Start Time -

Players must be signed in, on the court, and ready to play at specified game time. The clock will run until both teams have a minimum of four (4) players on the court, signed in, and ready to go. Any team arriving late or unable to start with 4 players will be penalized one (1) point per minute. After ten (10) minutes the game will be declared a forfeit if either team still does not have at least four (4) players. No time outs will be allowed during this time and tip-off cannot occur until all players have signed in with the scorekeeper.

## • Uniforms -

- Teams uniform must be the same color or same shade of color. Teams are responsible for providing alternate jerseys incase both teams have similar colors.
- Home team is designated as light-colored jerseys and Visiting team is designated as dark colored jerseys.

- Written numbers and tape will not be allowed on jerseys.
- Uniform rules will be enforced by week #3. Opponent to receive 2 Free-Throws for <u>each</u> violation.
- Overtime If the score is tied at the end of regulation time, a three (3) minute running clock (stop clock at last minute) overtime will be played. If a tie still exists, sudden-death overtime will be played, first team to score four (4) points will be declared winner. A jump ball will begin the overtime and sudden-death period.
- <u>Timeouts</u> Teams are allowed two (2) timeouts per half and one additional timeout for overtime periods. Timeouts do not carry over at halftime or into overtime play. One (1) timeout is given to each team in overtime.
- <u>Free-Throws Players</u> may enter the key on free-throws once the ball has been <u>released</u> by the shooter. However, players behind the 3-point line must wait until the ball hits the rim to enter the key. Shooter must also wait until the ball hits the rim to enter the key.
- <u>Personal Fouls</u> Five (5) personal fouls and a player will foul out of the game. A
  technical foul <u>will</u> count as a personal foul and a team foul.
- <u>Playoff Eligibility</u> All players must play a <u>minimum of 4 games</u> (half of the regular season) to be eligible for playoffs.
  - Player must be present to sign-in (No Exceptions)
- <u>Last Day of Roster Addition</u> The last day to add players to your roster will be the
   6<sup>th</sup> week on October 29, 2023
