- 1. <u>League</u>: A nine game season will be provided for Divisions "A-C". The season concludes on November 20 for all divisions.
- 2. <u>Coaches</u>: We are always in need of coaches! Experience is not necessary but does help. A manual and coaching clinic will be provided for new coaches. If you are interested in coaching, please contact 626-569-2265 to fill out a volunteer application. If not enough coaches volunteer in your child's division, some players will not be able to participate and will be refunded accordingly (last participant's to register).
- 3. <u>Player Evaluations:</u> There will be no Player Evaluation for Fall 2021 Season.
- **4.** <u>Meet & Greet:</u> Saturday, September 11 at Rosemead Community Center (3936 N. Muscatel Ave.)

**<u>Division:</u>** Division A - C (6-14 yrs. old): Time: 12:00 p.m.

- 5. <u>Practices</u>: All practices will begin the <u>week of September 13</u>. Each team is limited to two practices per week and a maximum of one hour in duration. The practice site and time will be left up to the volunteer coach. There is no guarantee to what area of Rosemead your child's practice site will be located. Our first priority is to place children on teams according to their rating. It is the sole responsibility of the parent to provide transportation for their child to and from practices and games.
- **6.** <u>Games:</u> Will begin <u>Saturday</u>, <u>September 25.</u> A detailed game schedule will be provided the second week of practice.

The <u>only</u> exception will be for siblings to be placed on the same team if they are in the same age group or division.
