1. **League:** A nine (9) game season will be provided for Divisions "A-D". The season concludes on May 30 for all divisions.
2. **Volunteer Coaches:** We are always in need of coaches! Experience is not necessary but does help. A manual and coaching clinic will be provided for new coaches upon request. If you are interested in coaching, please contact (626) 569-2256 to fill out a volunteer application. If not enough coaches volunteer in your child's division, some players will not be able to participate and will be refunded accordingly (last participant's to register).
3. **Player Evaluations:** This is **mandatory** for **all** players. Player evaluations are vital to our organization as we attempt to provide equally balanced teams. These are **not** tryouts and everyone who registers will play. The player evaluations will be conducted on **Friday, February 28 at Garvey Intermediate School – 2720 Jackson Ave.** Please check-in at your assigned times.

**Time:**

- A. 6-8 yrs. old (Div. D) = 5:30 p.m.
  - B. 9-10 yrs. old (Div. C) = 6:30 p.m.
  - C. 11-14 yrs. old (Div. A - B) = 7:30 p.m.

4. **Meet and Greet:** The Meet and Greet event is a chance for participants to meet their team and coach. The Meet and Greet will be held on **Saturday, March 14**, at the **Garvey Community Center – 9108 Garvey Ave.** Please arrive at your scheduled time:
    - A. 6-14 yrs. old (Div. A-D) = 9:00 a.m.
  5. **Practices:** All practices will begin the **week of March 16**. Each team is limited to two practices per week and a maximum of one hour in duration. The practice site and time will be left up to the volunteer coach. There is no guarantee to what area of Rosemead your child's practice site will be located. Our first priority is to place children on teams according to their rating. It is the sole responsibility of the parent to provide transportation for their child to and from practices and games.

6. **Games:** Will begin the **Saturday, March 28.** A detailed game schedule will be provided the second week of practice.
