1. I will place the emotional and physical well being of my players ahead of a personal desire to win.
2. I will remember to treat each player as an individual, remembering the large spread of emotional and physical development for the same age group.
3. I will do my best to provide a safe playing atmosphere for my players.
4. I promise to review and practice the necessary first aid principles needed to treat injuries of my players.
5. I will do my best to organize practices that are both fun and challenging for all my players.
6. I will ensure that I am knowledgeable in the rules of each sport that I coach, and that I will teach these rules to my players.
7. I will lead by example, in demonstrating fair play and sportsmanship to all my players.
8. I will use coaching techniques appropriate for each of the skills that I teach.
9. I will always treat all players, fellow coaches, parents, fans, and staff members with respect.
10. I will remember that I am a youth coach, and that the game is for children and not adults.
11. I will refrain from doing or saying anything negative in the presence or within earshot of children.
12. I will refrain from the use of or will not be under the influence of any drugs, tobacco, or alcohol at all City of Rosemead's games and events.
13. I will understand that any and all of my actions are subject to review by the City of Rosemead's Parks and Recreation Department.

I understand that failure to abide by the above Code of Ethics or any serious violation of the rules and guidelines may result in the removal, suspension or termination as a volunteer coach.
